Midlands South Handicap Stableford Event 2010.

Oakland Park Golf Club - 26th August 2010.

Qualifications

1. All entrants must be a member of a golf club affiliated to EWGA within the 6 counties of the South Midland Division (Bucks, Berkshire, Oxon, Northants, Warwickshire and Worcestershire and Herefordshire).
2. The event is open to female golfers who were Under 18 on the 1st January 2010.
3. The event is specifically limited to players in the handicap range 15.5 to 36 at time of entry.

Rules/ Information

4. The entry will be limited to a maximum of 54. In the event of entries exceeding this number the lowest handicap players will be accepted with priority going to those players who did not play at the main Midlands South Championship (to be played on August 16th at Northants County Golf Club). Each county will however be guaranteed 5 players to make up a team entry of 4 players plus one reserve.
5. If a girl lowers her handicap below 15.5 between entry and the date of the competition, she can still play and win but must play off her new handicap.
6. **Anyone reducing their handicap after entry and before the closing date should contact the organiser.**
7. A current CONGU handicap certificate must be produced when signing in. Inactive handicaps will not be accepted.
8. If there are more than 54 entries a reserve list will be kept and players notified by the organiser when they get in. Unsuccessful entrants will have their entry fees returned.
9. The format of the event is a stableford competition played off full handicap. There are individual and county team prizes. A county team shall consist of 4 players and teams will be nominated before the first tee time on the day of the event by the County Organisers to the Event Organiser. Counties may enter more than one team but each girl can only represent one team. For the team prize the best three scores out of 4 will count. In the event of a tie the fourth score will count.
10. All ties shall be decided an last 18,9,6,3 or 1 hole.
11. Trophies- Best Nett individual and Best County team.
12. Tee times will be from 11.30am and start times will be issued after the closing date by email to the email address given on the entry form. If a paper copy is required please enclose an additional stamped addressed envelope.
13. The entry fee must be paid on entry to cover meals and prizes and is non refundable.
14. Ball spotters and supervisors will be provided by the organising county.
15. Players should walk at all times unless prior permission has been sought from the organiser. Caddies are NOT allowed. Parents should NOT walk on the fairways or speak or give advice to their child during the competition.
16. The use of distance measuring devices is NOT permitted.
17. In all matters the decision of the organising Committee is final.
18. A fact sheet detailing more information about the event will be sent with the start sheet after the closing date.
19. In the event of adverse weather conditions, the organisers reserve the right to alter the format of the competition.
