

WHITE WINE

- 1 **Sauvignon Blanc** Duc de Chapelle, France £ 18.00
Aromatic Sauvignon, typically grassy with zesty lemon and lime character. Exotic gooseberry and grapefruit flavours develop on a well balanced palate ending with fresh rounded acidity. Recently one of France's Top 100 Vin de Pays. 175ml: £ 5.30
125ml: £ 3.90

- 2 **Pinot Grigio** Portenova, Veneto, Italy £ 18.00
A brilliant straw yellow colour, elegant perfume of acacia flowers, almonds and dried fruit. A soft, well-balanced palate combines citrus, exotic fruit and fresh apples. Elegant and dry. 175ml: £ 5.30

- 3 **Niersteiner Gutes Domtal** Schmitt Sohne, Germany £ 18.00
The vineyards of Nierstein, on the banks of the Rhein, provide classic mineral and citrus flavours from well-situated Riesling vines. Floral aromas of elderflower and honeysuckle mingle with ripe pear and finish with a touch of sweetness and lemony acidity. 175ml: £ 5.30

- 4a **Sauvignon Blanc** 'Wairau River', Marlborough, New Zealand £ 23.30
A clean classic Sauvignon Blanc from the beautiful Marlborough vineyards located in the maritime coastal plains of New Zealand's south island. Expressive aromas of gooseberry and passionfruit, with a finish of great length. 175ml: £ 6.20
125ml: £ 4.50

- 4 **Gavi** Tenuta Neirano, Italy £ 21.20
Made from Piedmont's native Cortese vines. The aroma is perfumed with honeysuckle and almond and the palate is beautifully balanced, finishing with a distinct bittersweet sensation.

- 5 **Unwooded Chardonnay** 'Stone Cutting', Paulett Wines, Clare Valley, South Australia £ 24.80
Aromas of honeydew melon, peach and shortbread. Unoaked, yet complex with a cream texture and a palate of butterscotch and caramel backed by grapefruit acidity and long finish.

- 6 **Mâcon Lugny** Louis Latour, Burgundy, France £ 24.20
Louis Latour is one of the top names in Burgundy and this sophisticated wine has a well defined buttery, lemon bouquet and crisp fruit flavours. 175ml: £ 6.35
125ml: £ 4.70

- 7 **Chablis** Domaine N&G Fevre, France £ 32.00
This is a lively and fresh Chablis with clean citrus aromas. Crisp and fruity on the palate with a good steely character.

RED WINE

- 8 **Cabernet Tinta Barocca 'John B'** Rietvallei Estate, Robertson, South Africa £ 18.00
Lots of attractive fruit flavours on the nose carry through onto the palate with an additional hint of spiciness. Well balanced with a touch of toastiness and lingering after taste. 175ml: £ 5.30
125ml: £ 3.90
- 9 **Merlot** La Vigneau Vin de Pays d'Oc, France £ 18.00
Soft and appealing, concentrated with blackcurrant and summer fruits. It has a nose of ripe berry fruit and hints of leather and mineral. There is a complex, supple palate with herbs, violets and blackberry fruit. 175ml: £ 5.30
125ml: £ 3.90
- 10 **Rioja Tempranillo** Azabache, Spain £ 18.00
A vibrant, unoaked and supple red, made exclusively from Tempranillo grapes grown in the dry Baja region of Rioja. This plummy, soft seductive wine exhibits typical Tempranillo character of red fruits and liquorice and finishes soft and rounded. 175ml: £ 5.30
125ml: £ 3.90
- 11 **Shiraz** 'Pimpala Road', Geoff Merrill, McLaren Vale, Australia £ 21.00
This fantastic wine is great value and delivers an aroma and palate to show off the full spectrum and complexity of this varietal. Aromas of spice and blackcurrant, the palate is fleshy medium weight with hints of dark chocolate, spice and a firm finish. 175ml: £ 5.90
125ml: £ 4.20
- 12 **Malbec** Altosur, Mendoza, Argentina £ 23.00
Aromas of intense ripe fruit, cherries, blackberries, blueberries, and fresh plums, combined with spicy and floral hints. A wine of good intensity, concentration and long after taste.
- 13 **Rioja Reserva** Azabache, Rioja, Spain £ 23.50
Well balanced with a soft seductive character typical of the Tempranillo and Garnacha grapes. This wine exhibits intense plummy fruits with hints of vanilla, spice and a soft rounded palate.
- 14 **Château Gironville** Médoc, Cru Bourgeois, Bordeaux, France £ 32.80
A dark ruby red and purple robe, with a lot of aromas of raspberries and blackberries. Soft on the palate, with a good dose of lovely, supple tannins. A well rounded and very pleasant finish.
- 15 **Rampant Red** Shiraz Cabernet Merlot, Hamelin Bay, Margaret River, Australia £ 26.95
Brilliant clarity with medium intensity with a cherry red centre and pink purple hue. Aromas of mint and earth harmoniously meld with cherry, plum and berry fruits to afford a complex bouquet. The palate is round and of medium weight with fine tannins.
- 16 **Pinot Noir** 'Turning Head' Marlborough, New Zealand £ 26.80
This cherry coloured wine has clean fresh fruit aromas. The palate has ripe fruit characters of plums and raspberries along with smokey oak and well integrated tannins. A medium bodied wine with a sustained finish.

ROSE WINE

- 17 **Cabernet Rose** Domaine de la Grande Courtade, France £ 18.80
A delicate salmon pink rosé with fruity flavours and aroma. Dry with a perfumed bouquet of summer fruits, vibrant fruit on the palate and crisp acidity. 175ml: £ 5.10
125ml: £ 3.70

CHAMPAGNE AND SPARKLING WINE

- 18 **Prosecco Brut** Borgo Col del Alto, Italy £ 21.00
Pale and delicate with a fine mousse and persistent bubbles. The clean fruity aromatic bouquet contains a hint of flowers, honey and apple leading to a well balanced, light and fresh palate.
- 19 **Vauban Freres Brut**, Champagne, France £ 32.50
Medium bodied with apple and lemon fruit flavours and a classically yeasty style.
- 20 **Lanson Black Label** Champagne, France £ 42.00
Well structured, lively Champagne that demonstrates a powerful edge that softens with bottle age.

PORT

- 21 **Taylor's** Fine Ruby Port, Portugal £ 20.00
Deep garnet in colour and with a rich, warming satisfying style. £ 3.50
- 22 **Taylor's** 10 year old Tawny Port, Portugal £ 35.00
Taylor's consistently produce one of the best ten-year old 'wood-aged' tawny ports, with its lovely sweetness and richness alongside its toffee, raisins, figs and plums flavours. £ 6.40
