Elite Training:

5 Sessions were held at various clubs throughout the County, as well as one at The Oxfordshire for extra Nationals Finals Training and we are extremely grateful to those clubs who allow us to hold these sessions on a weekend at their busy clubs.

The sessions combine short game skills tests alongside foursomes match practice, which once again proved invaluable throughout County and National Finals Week.

County Week - Kings Norton, Birmingham:
